- Credit will not normally be granted for formal study completed more than five (5) years prior to application unless there is evidence of continued relevance of this study for the course towards which credit is sought.
- Each subject at WIN Higher Education is equivalent to 10 credit points. A Bachelor's degree requires 240 credit points (24 subjects) to complete. A full-study load per year is 80 credit points (8 subjects).
